On Sunday the 2024 U18 National Championships concluded with fantastic results for South Australia.


The Men's Grand Final was hotly contested with SA Metro unfortunately falling 91-96 to Victoria Metro, but coming away as Silver Medallists!

Throughout his four years in high school, he exhibited exceptional talent, culminating in a remarkable achievement as he helped clinch the state championship in 2018, marking a significant milestone in his basketball career.

Transitioning to the collegiate level, Dibiamaka initially attended the University of Texas Rio Grande Valley. However, his journey took a turn when he made the decision to transfer to St. Edward's University. Despite the change in scenery, he seamlessly adapted to his new environment and made substantial contributions to the Hilltoppers' basketball program. During his tenure at St. Edward's, Dibiamaka showcased his prowess as a guard, leading the team to consecutive appearances in the Lone Star Conference Tournament. His exceptional performances on the court earned him accolades, including a spot on the LSC all-conference first team in his debut season with the Hilltoppers. In the subsequent season, he secured a spot on the all-conference second team, further solidifying his reputation as one of the conference's top players.
